

Executive Board met August 24, 2016 and every committee gave reports on their platform for the coming year.

September 20, 2016 we had our book discussion on Life In a Jar. The paper crane project was cancelled and replaced with gift bags for local police officers. We had a resignation from Kathy Burke.
